ABOUT THE WINE: The 2007 Olema Cabernet Sauvignon, made by *Amici Cellars*, is a beautiful blend of both valley floor and hillside grapes. The Cabernet Sauvignon in this wine comes from St. Helena in the heart of the Napa Valley. Merlot and a touch of Petit Verdot from Spring Mountain add complexity and roundness, making this a rich and layered wine that drinks well now and will continue to delight in coming years.

2007 VINTAGE: This excellent vintage began with a dry, warm spring leading to an early budbreak. Summer temperatures were mild and consistent, allowing clusters to ripen at an unhurried pace. The lack of rain early in the year gave us a smaller than average berry size, resulting in concentrated flavors of unusual depth and complexity.

WINEMAKER NOTES: This stylish Napa Cabernet displays ripe plum, berry and black cherry fruit with complex mocha, licorice and roasted oak characters. It is full-bodied with smooth tannins and a beautiful, lingering finish.
