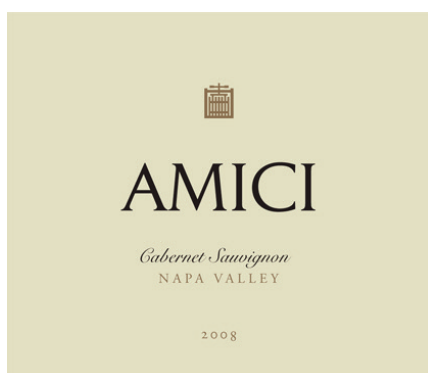

2008 AMICI CELLARS CABERNET SAUVIGNON NAPA VALLEY



ABOUT THE WINE: This 2008 Amici Cellars Cabernet Sauvignon is made from 80% Cabernet Sauvignon from the highly regarded Rutherford Bench, blended with 15% Cabernet Franc and 5% Merlot. The resulting wine drinks beautifully now but will age gracefully as is typical of wines from these benchland vineyards.

2008 VINTAGE: The 2008 vintage was marked by an extended, dry growing season, allowing extra “hang time” for the grape clusters. This additional time on the vine allowed the fruit to slowly ripen to perfection, deepening color and increasing the flavor complexity of the finished wine.

WINEMAKER NOTES: This full-bodied, rich wine shows complex aromas of wild berries, cedar and the elusive “Rutherford Dust,” which give way to flavors of blackberry, toffee, and mocha and a very concentrated, lingering finish.
