ABOUT THE WINE: The 2008 Olema Cabernet Sauvignon, made by Amici Cellars, is a beautiful blend of valley floor and hillside grapes. This 100% Cabernet Sauvignon comes from Alexander Valley, Rockpile and Russian River Valley areas of Sonoma County,

2008 VINTAGE: Winter precipitation was near normal until February, followed by a very dry spring. Ripening took place in ideally mild conditions characterized by contrasting warm summer days tempered by cool overnight lows and morning coastal fog. The resulting wines have ripe fruit and integrated tannins, yielding silky smooth wines that will cellar generously for the next 5 to 7 years.

WINEMAKER NOTES: This stylish Cabernet Sauvignon displays rich aromas of currants, cedar and espresso followed by pronounced black fruit toffee and mocha flavors. It is full-bodied with smooth tannins and a wonderful, lingering finish. *-Joel Aiken*
