**ABOUT THE WINE:** The 2009 Olema Cabernet Sauvignon, made by Amici Cellars, is a blend of 86% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Petit Verdot and 4% Merlot. The grapes for this wine come from valley floor and hillside vineyards in the Moon Mountain and Alexander Valley areas of Sonoma County.

**2009 VINTAGE:** 2009 was an exceptional vintage for Sonoma Cabernet Sauvignon. The region enjoyed an ideal long and temperate growing season with limited frost in April and some gentle rains in early May. Summer saw below normal temperatures and few heat spikes of any duration which helped produce excellent quality fruit with good flavors, color and in many cases lower alcohol wines with a pleasing acidity.

**WINEMAKER NOTES:** This stylish Cabernet Sauvignon displays complex aromas of cherry, currants, cedar and espresso followed by dark berry fruit and mocha flavors. It is full-bodied with smooth tannins and a wonderful, lingering finish.
