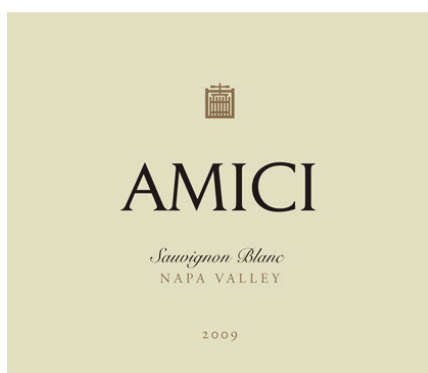

2009 AMICI CELLARS SAUVIGNON BLANC NAPA VALLEY



ABOUT THE WINE: This 2009 Amici Sauvignon Blanc is a blend of the best grapes from a small vineyard located on the valley floor between the town of Yountville and the Silverado Trail. The wine is a blend of 50% Musque clone and 50% #530 clone.

2009 VINTAGE: A dry winter led to springtime rains, and the vines responded vigorously. Berry development progressed under ideal conditions with morning fog lifting to warm and clear summer days. Ripening progressed slowly and evenly. Naturally low yields contributed to intense, full wines.

WINEMAKER NOTES: Crisp minerality and a hint of citrus balance the richness of guava, spice and honeysuckle in this graceful Sauvignon Blanc. Serve this food-friendly wine lightly chilled. It pairs especially well with grilled fish, poultry and light pasta dishes.
