The 2007 Amici Cellars Cabernet Sauvignon is a blend from several excellent vineyards in the Napa Valley. The winemaker hand-selected the highest quality grapes from valley floor vineyards on Zinfandel Lane in St. Helena and Maple Lane in Calistoga, and blended them with the finest grapes from high on Spring Mountain. The result is a beautifully balanced wine with the hallmarks of its origins: lush fruit of valley floor vineyards, framed by firm but supple hillside tannins. This wine displays pleasing aromas of juicy berries overlaid with hints of coffee and cedar. The flavors showcase layers of blackberries and mocha, framed by velvety soft tannins. Excellent paired with grilled steaks or semi-soft cheeses.
