Amici Cellars Announces New Harvest Retrospective Tasting

Celebrate Harvest with a Rare Single-Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon Retrospective Tasting Experience

(Napa Valley, Calif.) – September 2019 – For its 27th harvest, the team at Amici Cellars is, for the first time, opening their library for an opportunity to enjoy a retrospective tasting of its single-vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon from [Spring Mountain](#), [Morisoli](#) and [Becktoffer Vineyards' Missouri Hopper Vineyard](#). This rare tasting opportunity includes select library vintages, barrel previews of future releases, as well as a splash of fresh-pressed juice from the day's harvest. The guided tasting in the winery's private tasting room offers visitors a birds-eye view of the winery's crush pad and cellar with all the action of the 2019 harvest underway.

The 90-minute tasting is offered mid-week (Monday-Friday) September 1, 2019 through November 1, 2019, by appointment only for groups of four to eight. Advance reservations are required. Priced at \$90 per person, *Amici Cellars' Harvest Retrospective* includes a winery tour along with two retrospective tasting flights spotlighting two of the vineyards in Amici's single-vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon portfolio.

Each vineyard flight will include a library vintage, the corresponding current vintage and barrel tasting, as well as the opportunity to acquire select library wines (*three wines per critically acclaimed vineyard/six wines total*). Library vintages may vary; highlighting wines like the 2010 Amici Spring Mountain Cabernet Sauvignon, the 2012 Amici Morisoli Cabernet Sauvignon and the 2013 Amici Becktoffer Vineyards Missouri Hopper Cabernet Sauvignon.
